LINE EXTENSION INDETERMINATE AND OTHER SERVICE CLASSIFICATION

<u>Indeterminate and Other Classification</u> – Applicants under this classification include:

- (1) Facilities which do not meet the criteria for placement under any of the other listed classifications.
- (2) Seasonal facilities, such as hunting camps, fishing camps, baseball fields, parks, and other types of recreational areas.
- (3) All facilities involved in the production, handling, and/or processing of oil or natural gas, such as oil wells, tank batteries, compression plants, saltwater wells, injection wells, cathodic protection units, or rectifiers.
- (4) Any facility where the usage of electric energy is estimated to be not sufficient to eliminate stranded costs associated with electric facilities placed into service which are not adequately utilized.

If the estimated cost of construction is greater than \$15,000, the Charge for Construction will include the estimated cost of construction plus a 50% system impact fee which is necessary to mitigate potential stranded costs associated with electric facilities placed into service which are not adequately utilized.

Line extensions and/or system improvements in this classification shall be performed only if the Applicant pays, in advance, charges for the new construction and/or system improvements.

If, in the Cooperative's opinion, the means in which the facility is used justifies reclassification from Indeterminate to Permanent, then the Cooperative shall refund to the original Applicant any construction charge for which the Applicant would have been eligible at the time of the original extension of service, provided the Member makes a request for reclassification within one year of the original extension of service.
